

I'm not getting much read through to my second book, though I've gotten descent reviews on the first book. The third book in the series in going live on May 18th and I think it might be time to re-present the first book.

## THE BIG THREE

**Cover -** Dark and difficult to determine genre. In addition, the other book covers in the series are not branded. A new cover is a must.

**Title -** The title does not contain words or phrases synonymous with vampire stories. Consider a word bank search of "vampire" and then create a new title utilizing one or more of those words. The subtitle works if the main title(s) are changed.

**Sales Copy** - Tag line not bad. First section is repetitive. Second section is too vague. Need to raise the stakes. Vampires thrown in at end as an afterthought. The combination in the last section is dissonant. Those things don't seem to go together. Has a CTA, but awkwardly worded. Need a sense of urgency.
